These tasks each week will relate to someone who is there to help us.

This week we will be exploring the work of doctors, nurses and dentists.

Other Areas of Learning: To complete throughout the week

Expressive Arts and Design:

- Can you make a model crocodile like the one from our story this week?
- Look at the shape of your teeth in the mirror and have a go at making some teeth from playdough.
- Can you make a thank you picture for all of the doctors and nurses who are working super hard to make people feel better?

Communication and Language:

- What do doctors, nurses and dentists do? Who do they look after? Where do they work? What is different about doctors and nurses? How are dentists different?

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- This week in English we are thinking of the story 'Beware of the Crocodile'. Can you discuss what the word beware means with your grown up? What else might you have to beware of? Can you make a little poster with some drawings of examples?
- Can you have a go at the 'people who help us matching game' and see if you can match the problem to the person who could help? Could you play a pairs game with someone in your house and make sure you take turns each time?

 - Can you go on a rainbow scavenger hunt around the house and/or garden? What can you find? See the prompt sheet on our class page to help you!
 - Use the x-ray images on our class page to look at different bones in the body. Can you match them to their places in your body?
