English: Poetry

CHALLENGE: Write a haiku poem about the topic of your choice, it could be all about yourself, a pet, lockdown, summer- anything you like!

Tuesday: **To plan and create a shape poem.** Last week we also looked at shape poetry, today is your chance to create your own spring shape poem. Just like we do in class, brainstorm spring words and adjectives. Look at the shape poem PowerPoint and outline worksheets to help you.

Wednesday: **To plan and write a sound poem.** Watch and listen to Roger McGough perform his poem 'The Sound Collector'. <https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/clips/zc6qxn timer> Listen and record different sounds you can hear around your house and garden and write your own sound poem.
