Mathematics:

Our learning objective this week is to compare weight.

Homework: Can you find something that is heavy and something that is light?

Literacy:

This week in literacy we are reading the story of The Little Red Hen. Can you describe the characters and retell/order parts of the story? (If you do not have this story book at home you can find it on google/ youtube).

Homework: Please share your child's library book (they will be changed every Tuesday).

Other Areas of Learning:

This week we are learning about our emotions and feelings.

Expressive Arts and Design:

- Can you make a picture/craft of The Little Red Hen?
- Can you make your own emotion stone by finding a stone and drawing/ painting a face of how you are feeling?

Communication and Language:

- Can you listen to the story of The Little Red Hen and talk about how you think the hen is feeling when the other animals would not help?
- Can you retell parts of the story? Which part of the story is your favourite?

PSED:

- Can you talk about your feelings? What makes you happy, sad and angry?
- Can you talk about your family, friends and people who are important to you. How do they make you feel? What do you enjoy doing together?

Physical Development:

- The Little Red Hen made some bread in the story, with an adult can you spread butter and jam (or a topping of your choice) on some bread.
