- This week in maths we are looking at pairs of objects and items.
- Homework: Can you find some matching pairs around your house (socks, shoes etc)? Discuss what makes them pairs with your grown up.

## <u>English:</u>

## Other areas of Learning:

- Expressive art and design: Can you recreate one of the settings in the story using things around your house? (river, mud, grass etc)
- **Communication and language**: Can you talk to your grown up about what sorts of clothes you would wear to go on a bear hunt? What if it was cold? What if it was a beautiful day like it is in the story?
- **PSED**: As you go through the story can you think about how the characters in the story might be feeling at different points? How do they feel when they set off? How do they feel when they spot the bear?
- Physical development: Can you build a bear cave? What could you use? How could you make it dark?
- Understanding the world: Can you find out some information about bears? What type of bear do you think is in the story and why?
