Maths:

- This week in maths we will be looking at positional language. Can you hold/move your favourite toy above your head? Under your arm? Through your legs? Around your tummy?

English:

- This week we are looking at the story of Cinderella.
- At the beginning of the story Cinderella's family receive an invitation through the door for Prince Charming's grand ball.
- Can you create your own invitation to your very own ball? Who would you invite? What would your guests wear? What time would the ball start?
- Continue to use phonics play to learn a new phase 2 sound. Please revise sounds s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d and g with your child.
- Please continue to share your child's school library book.

Other areas of Learning:

- **Expressive art and design:** Can you design a gown for Cinderella to wear to the ball? What about a new suit for Prince Charming?
- **Communication and language:** Can you learn the Cinderella song? Sing to the tune of Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star:
*Cinderella, very sad,
Her stepmum was mean and mad.
Cleaning house from morn till night,
Not a speck of dust in sight.
Will her prince ever appear?
Yes, he's got her shoe right here!*
- **PSED:** Can you think about how you would feel if you were Cinderella at the beginning of the story? Why would you feel like this? What about during the ball? What about at the end of the story?
- **Physical development:** Listen to some ballroom music, can you dance along? Can you dance to a song you'd play at your ball?
- **Understanding the world:** The grand ball takes place in the castle. Can you find out a fact about castles?
